Also ranked as one of California's safest cities, San Ramon is the perfect place to start a family and join a tight-knit community.

San Ramon's weather is a major benefit, drawing in residents who look forward to a surplus of sunny days, moderate temperatures and easy access to nature. This city sees an average rainfall of 19 inches per year compared to the 28-inch national average and sits 486 feet above sea level. The winter's lowest lows reach 40 degrees and the summer's hottest days cap at around 84 degrees.

Safety is another perk bringing families to this mid-sized town. Crime rates in San Ramon were 39% lower than the national average as of 2020. This area is also wealthier than most of California, with average annual salaries hovering around \$95,000. While expensive, this area has great schools and some of the best educational programs in the nation.

If you want to eat like the locals, Gianni's Italian Bistro is a family-owned-and-operated restaurant in San Ramon. This venue has ample meal choices, from homemade garlic bread to gnocchi to pasticcio. If you have room for dessert, you can't go wrong with the Tiramisu at this well-known eatery!

Katy's Korner is another local favorite residents flock to for delicious brunch! This restaurant's specialties consist of Icelandic pancakes, corned beef hash 'n eggs and blintzes with fresh blueberries. They also offer a myriad of options for omelets, eggs benedict, pancakes and much more! If you stop by for lunch, try their excellent hamburgers, sandwiches or salads.

If you're a fan of live music, attend the Summer Concerts in the Park series. This concert series showcases the best live bands in the Bay Area. Attendees can enjoy dancing and music or bring a blanket and chairs to relax and enjoy the lively outdoor environment.

The Art & Wind Festival is an annual event that features fine arts and crafts as well as specialty food vendors and entertainment options, including international music. There are also several family-friendly entertainment options such as children shows, family amusement zone, professionally choreographed kite flying and a free kit-making workshop.

The Las Trampas Regional Wilderness Park is a 5,778-acre park near San Ramon. The park is fully accessible and offers visitors various outdoor activities, including hiking and horseback riding. Trails lead all over the park, along with picnic areas and campsites where you can stay overnight.

San Ramon's Central Park is an excellent destination for families with children. It offers several outdoor activities such as hiking trails, tennis, volleyball, basketball courts, picnic areas and playgrounds. There are also walkways and benches for relaxation.

RoboGames was founded in 2004 and has grown into the world's largest open robot competition! This San Francisco-based competition invites the best minds from around the world to compete in over 50 different events, including combat robots, fire-fighters, LEGO bots, hockey bots, walking humanoids, soccer bots, sumo bots and even androids that do Kung Fu. Some of the robots are autonomous and some are remote, but all are super cool!

Established in 2004, Bay Area Derby is a full-contact, women's flat track roller derby league, consisting of four home teams, two competitive travel teams, a recreational program, skating and non-skating officials and many dedicated volunteers. This amateur sport has risen from an underground subculture to a pop culture phenomenon. No other league has grown faster, stronger and harder than the Bay Area Derby!

If you need to travel for work or pleasure, the Oakland International Airport is 13.7 miles from San Ramon, approximately a 30-minute drive. The next closest airport is San Francisco International Airport, about 25 miles away and a 40-minute drive.

If you prefer to travel by train, the West Dublin / Pleasanton Station is only about a 10-minute drive away! Another nearby train station is the Walnut Creek Station, a 17-minute drive.

This city also ranks in the top California cities for easy driving, which means getting to and from major transportation hubs, or just cruising around town, is generally a breeze.

Getaways & Employers



About an hour and a half drive from San Ramon is California's capital city of Sacramento. Here, you will find the Old Sacramento district, which is a National Historic Landmark and State Historic Park sitting along the Sacramento River, where you can shop and dine with an amazing view of the water!

About an hour drive from San Ramon is San Francisco. There are many attractions to visit in this historic town, but the most popular attraction is the Golden Gate Bridge. Some other attractions consist of seeing the seal at Pier 39, enjoying ice cream at Ghirardelli Square, seeing the amazing view of San Francisco from the top of Quint Towers and driving on the crooked road known as Lombard Street.

The top employers in San Ramon are Chevron USA, Bank of the West and GE Digital LLC, which employ thousands of San Ramon's residents. Robert Half International and Accenture LLP make up the bottom half of the top five employers.

San Ramon also hosts several technology companies and startups as well as a large number of small, independently owned businesses. At 5.2%, the unemployment rate in this city is lower than the national average of 6%.
